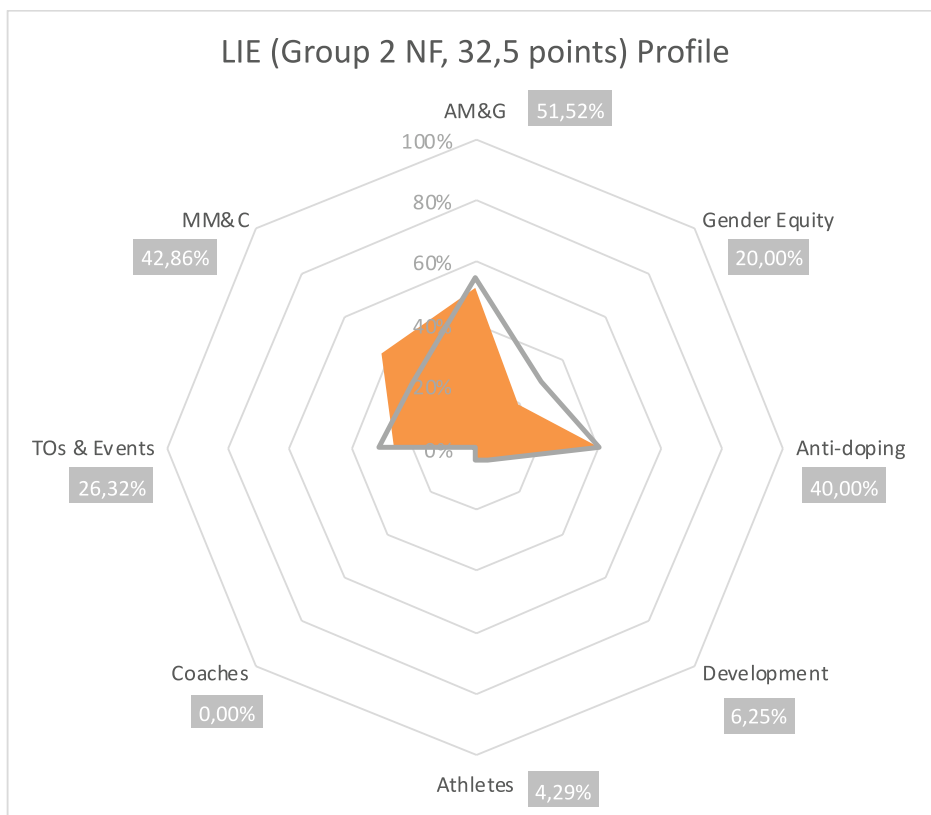

Evaluation

2019

The key areas of *Development*, including *Athletes*, *Coaches*, *Technical Officials* and *Events*, are yet to be focused on. This process should be supported by long-term strategic planning, considering current resources and opportunities at national level.

Involvement in educational development projects offered by World Triathlon via the Continental Confederation for athletes, activators, coaches, technical officials and event organizers could help to accelerate the development in the country.

Applying for various IOC Olympic Solidarity World Programmes including Development of National Sports System (DNSS) and technical courses for coaches could be an excellent way to strengthen the relationship with the National Olympic Committee and get funding to start.

Please make sure that National Championships results are submitted to World Triathlon at entries@triathlon.org. The survey submission and submitted national results show discrepancy that can be easily solved and would result in raking points for your athletes on various World Triathlon Rankings.

2018

The National Federation is in the advanced phase of the establishment of the sport structure. Following the stabilisation of *Administration, Management and Governance* the next step would be to get involved in ETU Development Projects (for further reference see the 2019 ITU-ETU Development Agreement). We do encourage the NF to participate on ITU Annual Congress in order to get familiar with our procedures and projects, and also build rapport to other NFs and ITU.

Getting involved in the development work of ETU / ITU firstly requires identifying coaches, technical officials and event organisers who could and are willing to participate on relevant courses and seminars. A good start would be to host an ITU Activator Community Seminar in Lichtenstein in conjunction to the Triathlon National Championships. To increase the number of athletes the NF may establish a talent identification program possibly linked to similar school initiatives and use the opportunities (for both coaches and athletes) of Continental Camps offered by ETU.

In the next phase the most important areas of development are *Athletes* and *Coaches*, then building on these fundamentals of participants the domain of *Development* and also *Technical Officials & Events*.

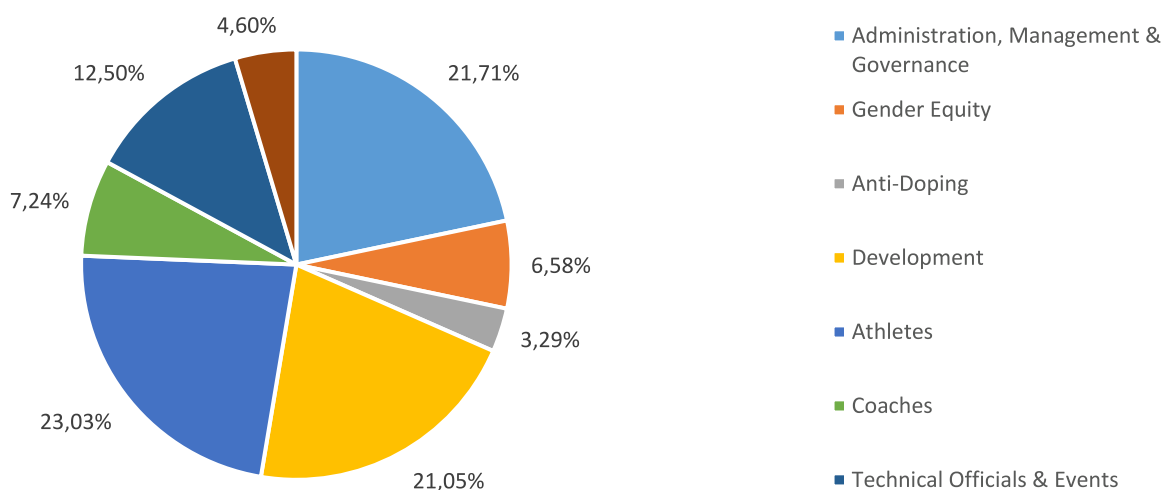

1. INDICATORS

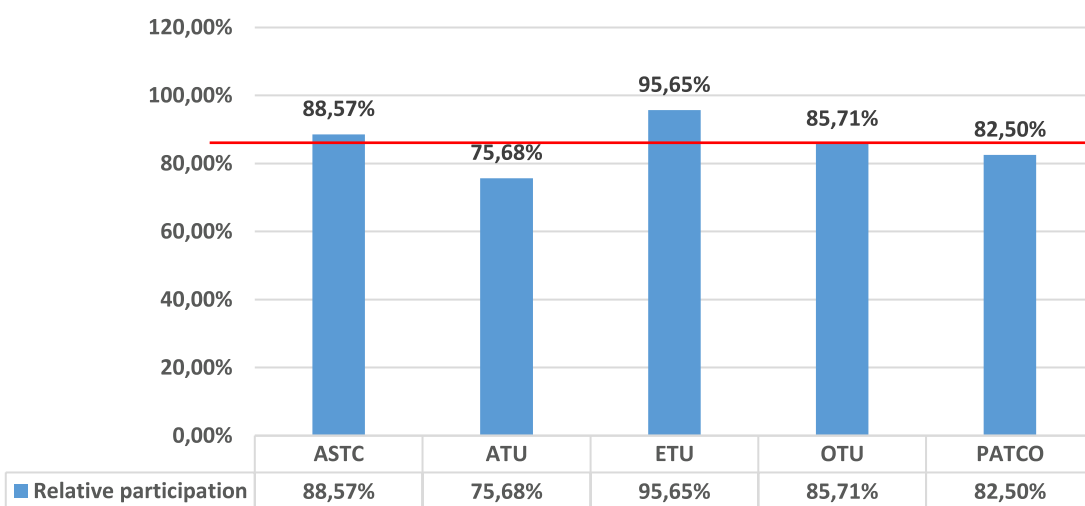
2. Two METHODS of data collection

- a. World Triathlon National Federation Survey in 3 languages (English, Spanish, French) with an improved online (SurveyGizmo instead of last year's JotForm) tool, that nearly eliminated the use of offline Excel spreadsheets
 - i. First email by World Triathlon President on 13 February 2020.
 - ii. First reminder on 27 February 2020.
 - iii. Continuous reminders and phone calls to non-responding National Federations until the end of the extended deadline (30 June). Last submission received by Panama NF using the outdated 2018 excel form, no response on requested further actions.
 - iv. The survey data collection cut-off date was 30 June 2020. The original deadline was extended due to the Covid-19 pandemic and the extended affiliation deadline for the good standing status by the World Triathlon Execution Board.
- b. World Triathlon Data Collection
 - i. From various World Triathlon databases and the back-end (Technical Officials, Coaches, Facilitators, Paratriathlon Classifiers, Events, Results, etc.).

3. National Federation PARTICIPATION

With the latest addition of American Samoa World Triathlon has 172 affiliated National Federations on the five continents. In case of ETU Gibraltar is a special NF as they are not affiliated to their Continental Confederation.

- World Triathlon Accredited Coaches Education Programme (ACEP)
- World Triathlon Accredited NF Technical Officials Education Programme (ATOEP)
- Having Qualified for Paralympic Games
